Resene CoolColour technology is available in a range of Resene premium paints and stains, including Resene Waterborne Woodsman, Resene Woodsman Wood Oil Stain and Resene Woodsman Decking Oil Stain, suitable for a wide range of exterior projects, especially where dark colours are planned. Ask your Resene ColorShop or reseller staff whether a Resene CoolColour finish is right for your project.

NB: The final finish will vary depending on the timber you are staining. Always view a physical sample before making your final choice and try out your colour on a representative sample of the timber you intend to use before completing your full project. Stains require regular maintenance. While this maintenance is required more regularly for stained surfaces than painted surfaces, the lower level of preparation required makes maintenance work easier to complete.



For a wood effect finish over preprimed substrates, use Resene Forester.

Resene Forester (see Data Sheet D510) is a semi-transparent film forming timber stain effect finish based on a tough 100% acrylic resin to ensure maximum durability in all exposed conditions. It imparts a natural low sheen look that is fully washable. Resene Forester is designed for use over a specific basecoat colour on properly prepared substrates and particularly those with a wood

grain effect, such as Shadowclad® Ultra. It is not suitable for direct application over timber and other bare substrates.

Preparation



Moss & Mould Killer (see Data Sheet D80). For existing stained surfaces, remove all the weakly adhering coating by sanding and treat the surface for mould using Resene Moss & Mould Killer.

If your substrate is previously coated in a mineral oil based wood finish, it must continue to be coated in the same finish.
