- Sandpaper
- Set square
- Paintbrush
- Pencil
- Resene Aquaclear satin
- Resene Colorwood testpots in Resene Apollo Blue, Resene Desert Yellow, Resene Deep Purple, Resene Emerald, Resene Red Pepper and Resene Satin Orange


Step two
Apply one coat of Resene Desert Yellow to four of the cubes and allow to dry. smooth any rough edge with sandpaper.

## Step five

Apply one coat of Resene Emerald to four of the cubes and allow to dry.


Step three
Apply one coat of Resene Satin Orange to four of the cubes and allow to dry.


## Step seven

Apply one coat of Resene Deep Purple to four of the cubes and allow to dry.

It's easy to create these colourful traditional building blocks using a few Resene Colorwood testpots.


## To get the look:

Mark painted the table with Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Woodstock.


## Other ideas:

Blocks could also be primed with Resene Quick Dry and then painted with Resene testpots from the Resene KidzColour range.

## Step eight

Apply three coats of Resene Aquaclear satin to all the blocks, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.
