You will need:

- Clean cloths
- Methylated spirits
- Old picture frame with fitted glass
- Paintbrush
- Resene Quick Dry

- Resene testpots of Resene Galliano and Resene Wild Thing
- Resene testpot roller
- Sandpaper



Step one Lightly sand the picture frame to 'key' the surface.



Step two Wipe off any sanding residue with a clean cloth.



Step three Spot prime any areas of bare wood with Resene Quick Dry and allow two hours to dry.



Step four Wipe clean both sides of the glass with methylated spirits and allow to dry.



Transform an old

picture frame and piece of glass into this colourful

marker board.



Step five Turn the frame and glass over so it's face down and cut in around the edge of the glass with Resene Wild Thing.



Step six Paint the remainder of the glass with Resene Wild Thing using the testpot roller. Allow to dry.



Step seven Apply a second coat of Resene Wild Thing to the glass and allow to dry.



Step eight Turn the frame and glass over and paint the frame with two coats of Resene Galliano, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



For a fabulous blue marker board paint the glass with Resene Anakiwa and the frame with Resene Half **Resolution Blue.**
