- Clean cloth
- Filler
- Mirror in wooden frame •

- Paintbrush
- Putty knife or similar
- Resene Quick Dry



- Sandpaper
- Small stick for stirring paint

It's easy to give a plain framed mirror the metallic 'wow' factor with a little bit of help from Resene.



To get the look: Mark painted the background wall with **Resene SpaceCote** Flat tinted to Resene Silver Chalice.



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Step five Apply one coat of Resene Tory Blue to the frame and allow to dry.



Step two Fill holes any or imperfections in the frame with filler and allow to dry.



Step three Lightly sand the frame and wipe off any sanding residue with a clean cloth.

**Step four** Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry to the frame and allow to dry.

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Step six Carefully stir the Resene Zoop De Loop with the small stick.



Step seven Apply two coats of Resene Zoop De Loop to the frame, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step eight Replace the mirror and backing board into the frame.



For a rich purple effect paint the mirror frame with one coat of **Resene Daisy Bush and** two coats of Resene Funtasia.
