Erina Emery's creative approach to decorating her Auckland home has won her first prize in the Resene Colour Home Awards. Resene marketing manager Karen Warman says Erina's use of strong colour makes her house stand out. "The attention to detail gives each room a unique personality that suits its use. ## The staircase

- + Built in the 1990s when another storey was added, Erina says the varnished staircase needed updating.
- + She made it a feature by laying rich red carpet and painting the stair rails to match the carpet.
- + Erina tried existing Resene reds but ended up making her own with the help of the friendly staff at her local Resene ColorShop in Mt Eden.
- + They came up with a perfect match and the colour is now called 'Emery Red'.

## DIY STRIPES

A patterned wallpaper in the toilet provided Erina with the inspiration for the colours she chose for the stripes in the bathroom.

- + This was a cost-effective way of linking the design in the bathroom with the toilet and, luckily for Erina, Resene were able to match the colours in the wallpaper.
- + Resene 'Alabaster', 'Royal Heath', 'Rakaia' and 'Eighth Oilskin' worked well, but when it came to applying the paint, Erina called in the Resene recommended painter Darren Cahn. There is no room for error in a job like this!
- + Resene have developed special waterproof and water resistant paints over the years for use in 'wet' areas such as bathrooms and laundries.
- + Preparation is the key to getting the best performance from your paint. It might take a bit longer, but taking a short cut will only result in mouldy, peeling paint.

## Fit for a princess

- ✦ Erina's inspiration for her daughter Zoe's room was some bright curtain fabric.
- ✦ Using Resene 'Alabaster' as a base for most of the walls, she then painted the back wall in Resene 'Illusion', a pretty pink, and matched the blue in the fabric with Resene 'Bunting'.
- ✦ A chair in the corner of the room was also painted Resene 'Bunting' to help tie the whole look together.
- ✦ To finish off the room, Erina added the magical mosquito net from Ikea and pretty matching bed linen that complements the paint colours beautifully.
- ✦ The result is a very special bedroom that Zoe loves spending time in. The perfect room for a little girl and fit for a princess!

“The children's rooms needed a major overhaul. I was conscious that the surfaces had to be hard wearing and practical (for all those 'accidents') and I knew that strong colours were the way to go.”



## Winning Style

Erina is a fashion designer and adopted a similar approach to decorating her house as she does to compiling garment designs. She spent months collecting ideas and putting them in a scrapbook. It's the sort of preparation that pays off when you are using a bold colour palette. Erina found inspiration with colourful curtain or blind fabric and matched the colours. She found it was an easier way to get started rather than flicking through piles of paint charts.
