Whites have long been a beloved choice for interiors. When layered together, they're anything but plain. In these calm, coastal-inspired schemes, walls in soft Resene Meringue flow seamlessly through archways into crisp Resene Alabaster. The timber floors stained in Resene Colorwood Breathe Easy add depth underfoot with their gentle grain balancing the lightness above.

The key to working with a white palette is variation and a well-placed accent. Pairing cooler and warmer undertones creates dimension while accents in earthy shades – like this plant pot in the tan-toned Resene Yogi and warm timber furniture – bring subtle contrast. Together these tones breathe life into the space, proving that neutral doesn't need to mean flat.

Texture is another important tool. Linen seating, woven rugs and sculptural ceramics in chalky finishes add softness and tactility, creating an inviting space. With neutrals, light dances across surfaces in the day while becoming gentle and cocooning at dusk.

The simplicity of whites also allows other details like a stylish lamp, curved sofa or sleek black fittings to sing. Far from being a blank backdrop, white is a canvas for effortless elegance and a tranquil base you'll never tire of.
