## What can we expect to see in 2019?

Lots of deep neutrals such as Resene Porter and Resene Extraterrestrial which are strong and determined; alongside a new wave of rich, bronzed neutrals like the sultry Resene Swizz Caramel.

Vintage reds such as Resene Courage are adding glamour paired with the likes of Resene Rose Gold, and blues and greys are blending to create moody, muted hues. Try Resene Artemis and Resene Triple Duck Egg Blue.

## How do these new trends differ from last year?

Colours are becoming more weathered and subtle, and we are continuing to appreciate soft, tonal transitions. Colours are becoming richer, warmer and more grounded. Pinks are becoming peachier and we are pairing nudes with fresh new tones of lilac.
