# Resene Sandtex

The time-worn strength of sandstone with the mellow patina of age has been recreated in Resene Sandtex. Perfect for beautifying and protecting concrete, this very versatile finish can be used to reproduce a variety of finishes from aged render effects through to natural limestone and sandstone finishes. The fine sandstone texture adds an extra dimension to the coating and effectively disguises minor surface blemishes without changing the basic architectural concept. The combination of strong colour and texture illustrated by the colours overleaf can transform an ordinary surface into an architectural feature.

Resene Sandtex can be rolled or sprayed to create a monolithic finish reminiscent of sponge finished or cement rendered plaster. Simply apply 1 thin coat of Resene Sandtex with a P.A.L. Hi-Solids Roller to provide an anchor for the second coat. Apply a second coat by roller at 6 square metres per litres. Alternatively, apply 1 coat using air spray at 4-6 square metres per litre in smooth even passes.

For an aged plaster or limestone finish simply apply 2 coats of Resene Sandtex using a P.A.L. Hi-Solids Roller at 6 square metres per litre and brush off in a random manner to achieve the desired effect.

With all application methods, a Resene Lumbersider or Resene X-200 basecoat (tinted to the same colour as the Sandtex) can enhance the final appearance.

Inherently durable, Resene Sandtex also provides an ideal basecoat for creating Mediterranean-style effects. The texture in Resene Sandtex adds an extra dimension to the paint effect. Its effect is not dissimilar to traditional limewashes or cement based paints.

Specifying Resene Sandtex is easy with the Resene One-Line Specification system:

Systems will vary depending on the condition of the substrate. For example, if the surface is porous, substitute Resene Sureseal for Quick Dry and topcoat in your chosen Resene Sandtex colour.

The finish will vary depending on application technique. Refer to the Resene Architectural Sample box for a standard panel. Try yourself or request your painter prepares a sample panel for you to agree to prior to commencing your project.
