Resene marketing manager Karen Warman says the pigment technology allows the coating to retain its usual colour, while the reflected heat reduces the stress on the coating and substrate, limiting subsequent heat-related damage.

"The technology also minimises the build-up of unwanted heat inside the house, keeping air conditioning and cooling costs down," Warman says.
