

## Pebble MOSa1C

Make a pretty glass pebble pot.

## You will need:

- Bowl-shaped terracotta pot
- Paintbrush
- Weldbond PVA glue
- Resene Terracotta sealer
- Resene testpot of Resene Alabaster
- Resene Multishield+ (gloss)
- Clear, opaque and white glass pebbles (our's came from Mitre 10 Mega)
- Good quality potting mix
- 3 white cyclamen plants

To get the look: Mark painted the background wall with Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Paua.



Apply one coat of Resene Terracotta sealer to the inside and outside of the terracotta pot and allow to dry for six hours.




Apply two coats of Resene Alabaster to the outside and inner rim of the pot, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Working with the pot upside down, attach one row of glass pebbles, as shown, fixing each one with a generous blob of PVA glue.



Apply a second row of pebbles above the first.



Apply a third and fourth row of pebbles around the pot, as shown.



Continue working in this way until the pot is covered in glass pebbles. Leave to dry overnight.



Apply one coat of Resene Multishield+ to the outer and inner rim of the pot, allowing two hours to dry.



Pot up with three white cyclamen plants and good quality potting mix.
