

Want some garden art without the hefty price tag? Paint up a storm with these arty pots.

You will need:

- 3 terracotta pots, the same shape and size
 Resene Lumbersider tinted to Alabaster
- Resene Sandtex
- tinted to Alabaster • Resene Multishield+
- flat
 - at
- Resene Hot Weather
- Additive
- Tracing paper
- Cardboard
- Masking tape
 Scissors
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- Pencil
- Paintbrushes

Note: If planting up, or using as a water feature, the inside of the pot should be primed first.



MAKE sure pots are clean before starting. Using a pencil, draw a design on to one side of one of the pots.



PLACE tracing paper over the design and secure with masking tape. Trace the design. This will ensure the design is the same on all sides.



PLACE the tracing paper on to cardboard and cut out the design. Use this stencil to draw your pattern around the pot.



APPLY a thinned basecoat (thinned with Resene Hot Weather Additive) of Resene Lumbersider to the two pots without the design.



APPLY a thinned basecoat of Resene Lumbersider to the stencilled pot, using a smaller brush

for tricky parts. Leave to dry.



APPLY two coats of Resene Sandtex. Care is needed to apply the Sandtex evenly or the aggregate may be pushed around, leaving bald patches.



RESENE Sandtex can be used to recreate the texture of concrete or natural sandstone. Once dry, apply a coat of Resene Multishield+.



PLACE pots in desired spot. Plant up, use as a water feature or leave as is. For more on paints phone o8oo RESENE or visit www.resene.co.nz
