

Paty Poly

MARK RAYNER creates a splash of winter warmth with this cheerful colourful planter.

To get the look

MARK used a "Long Tom" terracotta pot, available from most garden centres.

You will need:

- Terracotta pot
- Terracotta sealer
- 5 orange, yellow or red polyanthus
- Potting mix
- Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat
- Resene Lumbersider testpots in the following colours: Resene Paua, Resene Camarone, Resene Bilbao, Resene Turbo, Resene Red Berry, Resene Kaitoke Green, Resene Supernova
- Paintbrush
- Small roller



SEAL the inside of the pot with terracotta sealer. Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat to the outside. Allow to dry.



USING the roller, apply two coats of Resene Paua to the outside of the pot, allowing two hours between coats to dry.



USING one of the polyanthus plants as your guide, paint the main leaf shape with Resene Camarone. Allow to dry.



PAINT the leaf veins and edges with Resene Bilbao and the main flower shape with Resene Turbo. Allow to dry.



PAINT the edges of each petal with Resene Red Berry and use Resene Kaitoke Green to add some shadowing to the leaves.



PAINT the centre of each petal with a line of Resene Supernova. Allow to dry, then paint the eye of each flower with Resene Camarone.



ADD a little more Resene Bilbao to the leaf edges and veins to create highlights.



FILL the pot with potting mix and plant up with polyanthus. Place in a semi-shaded spot and keep the plants adequately watered.
