



Potted colour

Mark Rayner transforms a boring old pot into a floral masterpiece.

You will need:

- Terracotta pot
- Terracotta sealer
- Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat
- Resene testpots in the following colours: Resene Mariner, Resene Grass Hopper, Resene Corn Field, Resene English Holly, Resene Lightning Yellow
- Resene Multishield+ Gloss
- Paintbrushes
- Small Artist's brush

To get the look Mark planted up our daisy pot with the marguerite 'Summer Lustre'.

1 FOLLOWING the manufacturer's instructions, seal the inside of the terracotta pot using terracotta sealer. Allow to dry.



2 PRIME the outside, top edge and inner rim of the pot using Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat. Allow to dry.



3 PAINT the outside, top edge and inner rim of the pot with two coats of Resene Mariner. Allow to dry.



4 USING the artist's brush, paint daisy stems and leaves with Resene Grass Hopper. Allow to dry.



5 USING the artist's brush, paint daisy petals with Resene Corn Field. Allow to dry.



6 USING the artist's brush, paint blades of grass along the bottom edge of the pot with Resene English Holly. Allow to dry.



7 USING the artist's brush, paint the "eye" of each daisy with Resene Lightning Yellow. Allow to dry.



8 PAINT the outside, top edge and inner rim of the pot with two coats of Resene Multishield+ Gloss. Allow to dry.
