



Difficulty level ★ easy ★★ moderate ★★★ challenging

Resene kids art with Mark Rayner – 41



You will need:

- Paintbrushes
- Plain cardboard star box (ours came from 'Spotlight')
- Resene Art Action metallic paint in Resene Scotty Silver
- Resene KidzColour sticker
- Resene Quick Dry waterborne primer undercoat
- Resene testpot of Resene Bullitt



Step one

Paint both the inside and outside of the lid and base of the box with one coat of Resene Quick Dry waterborne primer undercoat and leave for about one hour to dry.



Step two

Paint the inside and outside of the base of the box with two coats of Resene Bullitt, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step three

Paint the inside and outside of the lid of the box with two coats of Resene Scotty Silver, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step four

Place a Resene KidzColour sticker in the centre of the lid and fill the box with all your favourite secret stuff.

Create your own fabulous star box using Resene paints and a cool Resene KidzColour sticker.



Top tip:

If you want your box to have an even shinier look, apply one coat of Resene Multishield+ gloss to the lid and allow two hours to dry before putting on the sticker.



Here's another idea:

Use a testpot of Resene Flash Point on the base and a Resene Art Action pot of Resene Bullion on the lid to create a rich gold effect.
