You will need:

- Clean cloth
- Caravan cupboard
- Paintbrushes
- Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Sazerac
- Resene Enamacryl tinted to Resene Suzie Q
- Resene Waterborne Smooth **Surface Sealer**
- Sandpaper



Step one Remove the cupboard and drawer handles.



Step two Lightly sand the cupboard, drawer front and handles with sandpaper to 'key' the surface.




Step three Wipe off any sanding residue with a clean cloth.



Step four Apply one coat of Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer to the cupboard, drawer front and handles and allow to dry.









Step five

Apply two coats of Resene Suzie Q to the drawer front, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step six

Apply two coats of Resene Suzie Q to the cupboard door, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step seven

Apply two coats of Resene Sazerac to the rest of the cupboard, including the handles. Allow two hours for each coat to dry.



Step eight Replace the cupboard and drawer handles.
