- Clean cloth
- Hammer
- MDF shelving unit
- Nail punch
- Paintbrush
- Paint stirrer

- Putty knife or similar
- Resene EzyFill Quick
- Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Alabaster
- Resene Quick Dry
- Sandpaper



Step oneCarefully punch any nail heads in the MDF unit.



Step twoFill the nail holes with Resene EzyFill Quick and allow to dry.



Step threeSand the filler and wipe off any sanding residue with a clean cloth.



Step fourCarefully stir the Resene
Quick Dry.



Step five

Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry to the MDF unit and allow two hours to dry.



Step six

Carefully stir the Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Alabaster.



Step seven

Apply one coat of Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Alabaster to the MDF unit and allow two hours to dry.



Step eight

Apply a second coat of Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Alabaster to the MDF unit and allow two hours to dry.





To get the look: Mark varnished the wooden floor with Resene Polythane.



Other ideas:
For a bold black effect
paint the MDF unit with
Resene Lustacryl tinted
to Resene Nero.
