

Avocado stool

You will need:

- Clean cloths
- Mineral turps
- Paintbrushes
- Paint stirrers
- Resene Interior Paintwork Cleaner
- Resene Paint Pot

- Resene Super Gloss enamel tinted to Resene Avocado
- **Resene Wood Primer**
- Sandpaper
- Wooden stool



Step one

Thoroughly clean the stool Resene Interior Paintwork Cleaner.



Step 2

Lightly sand the legs of the stool.



Step 3

Wipe off any sanding residue with a clean



Step 4

Carefully stir the Resene Wood Primer.



Step 5

Apply one coat of Resene Wood Primer to the legs and underside of the stool and allow to dry.



Step 6

Carefully stir the Super Gloss Resene enamel tinted to Resene Avocado.



Step 7

Apply one coat of Resene Super Gloss enamel tinted to Resene Avocado to the legs and underside of the stool and allow to dry. Apply a second coat if necessary and allow to




Step 8

Wash brushes in mineral turps.





To get the look: Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Flat tinted to Resene **Coconut Cream.**



Other ideas: For a bright yellow

effect paint the stool with Resene Fizz. You can use Resene **Enamacryl if you prefer** a waterborne finish.
