## You will need:

- Clean cloths
- Corner unit (ours was previously painted)
- Paint stirrer
- Paintbrushes
- Karen Walker Chalk Colour tinted to Resene Cooled Green
- Karen Walker Chalk Colour Soft Wax
- Resene Quick Dry
- Rubber gloves
- Sandpaper



Step 1 Lightly sand the corner unit to 'key' the surface.



Step 2 Wipe off any sanding residue with a clean cloth.



Step 3 Carefully stir the Resene Quick Dry.



Step 4 Spot prime any areas of bare wood with Resene Quick Dry and allow to dry.



Step 5 Carefully stir the Karen Walker Chalk Colour tinted to Resene Cooled Green.



Step 6 Apply one coat of Karen Walker Chalk Colour tinted to Resene Cooled Green to the corner unit and allow to dry.



Step 7 Apply a second coat of Karen Walker Chalk Colour tinted to Resene Cooled Green to the corner unit and allow to dry.



Step 8 Wearing rubber gloves, apply a layer of Karen Walker Soft Wax to the corner unit with a clean cloth. Wipe off any excess wax with another clean cloth and allow the wax to dry.



To get the look: Mark painted the background woodwork with Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Alabaster.

Use Resene Karen **Walker Chalk Colour** 

to quickly transform a plain corner unit into a stylish piece

of furniture.

Other ideas: For a subtle blue effect, paint the corner unit with Karen Walker Chalk **Colour tinted to Resene** Half Periglacial Blue.
