

Resene Colorwood is an exciting way of treating natural timbers and enhancing the grain. Gives coloured timbers with the see-through look as it allows the natural grain of all timbers to show through.

Preparation

- Ensure surfaces to be stained are free from oil, grease and
- If mould is present, treat with Resene Moss & Mould Killer (see Data Sheet D80).
- Stop all nail holes after staining with putty or a suitable filler matched to the required colour.
- Thoroughly sand surfaces prior to staining. Finish off with a fine sandpaper, remembering always to sand with the grain. Any marks left on the timber will show through Resene Colorwood
- Surfaces should be completely dust free. Vacuum clean to remove dirt, dust and loose material.
- All sanding dusts may be harmful and appropriate protection must be worn. In particular dusts from old lead or chromate based paints or old building materials containing asbestos may be injurious to health if inhaled or ingested. Seek expert advice if the presence of these materials is suspected.
- The finished colour is influenced by the colour of the timber itself. Always colour test to see that your choice of Resene Colorwood stain gives the result you want on the actual timber you are staining.
- Bright or light colours give the best result over pale coloured woods. Dark timbers may show a darker colour than desired finish.
- This product may be used on a wide variety of surfaces. If the surface you propose to stain is unsound or not referred to, try a small test area first or contact your local Resene ColorShop or Reseller for advice.

Application

- Before use and regularly during use stir well with a wide flat
- Apply one full coat of Resene Colorwood ensuring there are
- Leave for an appropriate time. Wipe off surplus immediately for the lightest stains, leave three minutes for pale shades or leave up to 5-15 minutes for a full strength colour.

- Avoid skin contact and wear gloves when wiping off any surplus. Wipe excess Resene Colorwood off with a dry, absorbent, lint free cloth rubbing along the grain. Surplus Resene Colorwood **must** be wiped off to ensure maximum adhesion
- If the colour is too strong use Resene Colorwood Reducing Base to lighten colours (and on its own to enrich the colour of grain).
- Allow 4 hours dry time before topcoating with Resene Aguaclear (see Data Sheet D59) or Resene Oristal ClearFloor (see Data Sheet D506 and D506A), 24 hours if overcoating with Resene Oristal Clear Polyurethane (see Data Sheet D52) or 48 hours if overcoating with Resene Polythane (see Data Sheet D53)
- Hardwood and heart timbers may resist penetration of Resene Colorwood, Strong colours may be difficult to achieve on these timbers and dry time will increase.
- Ensure enough stain of the same batch number is available to complete the job, as batch to batch colour variation can occur.
